2015 Las Trancas Vineyard Sauvignon Blanc

Farmed by Larry Hyde & Sons and planted in 1997. The vineyard in located along the southern border of the Oak Knoll district and is framed by the Napa River to the west, Las Trancas Blvd on the south and the famed Silverado Trail to the east. Planted in an East to West alignment and to a majority of Sauvignon Blanc, Wonderment was able to purchase a few tons of the Musque Clone allowing us to produce our first Vineyard Designate Sauvignon Blanc.

The 2015' Las Trancas Vineyard Sauvignon Blanc is Wonderment's first vintage of this classic white varietal. The wine was pressed whole cluster straight from the vineyard and racked to 50% Stainless Steel Barrel and 50% Neutral Burgundian Oak fermenting in barrel on its lees. The wine was again racked after fermentation and returned to the same percentage of Stainless and Neutral Oak where it rested for 5 months before being bottled on February, 26th 2016. The Las Trancas Sauvignon Blanc shows pear and lemon peel initially with a hint of baked lemon meringue. Its wonderful mouthfeel is followed by vibrant acidity and a touch of stony minerality. We are very excited to share this refreshing and lively wine from the Las Trancas Vineyard in the Oak Knoll District of Napa Valley.
